SUMMARY OF ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS OF CITING/REFEREE'S REPORT/INCIDENT FOOTAGE

The Referee issued a red card in the match to The Player, Tommi Galí Valls. The following was reported:

58 minutes of the game. 7 m for the sideline and 10 meters from the Warriors half. The score at that time was 20-10 for Warriors.

The ball carrier (Tommi Gali Valls Porvoo 19) getting in contact with the defender Tackler (WRC 10) and started Hand of the tacker in the face and the body, (many times) before going to the floor. At that moment the AR (Matias Solana) flagged me.

He told me, what he's so and it was exactly the same as me but on the ground he's so that the ball carrier swing the elbow straight to the back of the head of the tacker (Physical abuse)







As the sending off was the result of an Assistant Referee's report, further information was provided by him:

At the 58th minute of the game, the number 19 from the OTS Porvoo team (Tommi Galí Valls, referred later as the ball carrier) is running with the ball in open play after a pass. As he reaches the 10m line in the opponents half, about 7m away from the touch line, he gets grabbed by WRC number 10 (referred later as the tackler) with whom he battles, with both players on their feet, before being tackled by the tackler.

During the battling on their feet, the ball carrier repeatedly handed-off the tackler in the face with an open hand to fend him off and, as they were both falling to ground, hit the tackler with the elbow on the back of the tackler's head.

I immediately flagged the incident and called the referee to report what I saw.

The Player's club, as the home team, provided a YouTube link to the match footage which showed the incident.
